<b>2 Timothy 2:15</b>	Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
<b>Proverbs 30:5-6</b>	Every word of God is flawless; he is a shield to those who take refuge in him. Do not add to his words, or he will rebuke you and prove you a liar.
<b>2 Peter 1:16</b>	We did not follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty.

<b>Luke 1:1-2, 4</b>	Many have undertaken to draw up an account of the things that have been fulfilled among us, just as they were handed down to us by those who from the first were eyewitnesses and servants of the word...so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.
<b>Romans 16:26</b>	But now revealed and made known through the prophetic writings by the command of the eternal God, so that all nations might believe and obey him.
<b>2 Peter 1:21</b>	For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.
<b>Jeremiah 28:9</b>	But the prophet who prophesies peace will be recognized as one truly sent by the LORD only if his prediction comes true.
<b>Deuteronomy 18:22</b>	If what a prophet proclaims in the name of the LORD does not take place or come true, that is a message the LORD has not spoken. That prophet has spoken presumptuously. Do not be afraid of him.
<b>Acts 16:29-31</b>	The jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household."
<b>Ephesians 2:8-10</b>	For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
<b>Exodus 20:3-5a</b>	You shall have no other gods before me. You shall not make for yourself an idol in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them

<b>Exodus 20:7a-8</b>	You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God... Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.
<b>Exodus 20:12-15</b>	Honor your father and your mother, so that you may live long in the land the LORD your God is giving you. You shall not murder. You shall not commit adultery. You shall not steal
<b>Exodus 20:16-17</b>	You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor. You shall not covet your neighbor's house. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.
<b>Romans 3:20</b>	Therefore no one will be declared righteous in his sight by observing the law; rather, through the law we become conscious of sin.
<b>Titus 3:5</b>	He saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit...
<b>Romans 3:28</b>	For we maintain that a man is justified by faith apart from observing the law.
<b>Mark 12:30</b>	Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength
